Special Thanks, to Hark S. for organizing the PAC Concession and her team of volunteers for keeping our many athletes and their families well fed and hydrated.

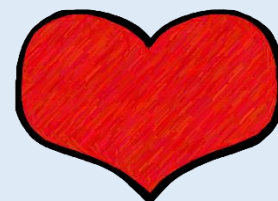
PAC supported our alumni volunteers by sponsoring a pizza lunch. It was wonderful to have over 50 alumni return and help with the day's events.
